To thoroughly rebuild a lift truck engine, a good business would initially totally disassemble it. A heat cleaning system is then utilized to clean all of the components. Once this step has been done, all of the parts are checked to see if they have any defects, any breakage or any extensive wear. Certain parts like connecting rods, cylinder heads, crankshafts and cylinder blocks are reground, resurfaced and resized if necessary. Various components like for example gears, nuts, bolts and all that are replaced or repaired as considered necessary.

When the overhaul has been done, the engine is rebuilt by hand. After being reassembled, a series of tests are applied to the running machinery so as to check all of the parts and be sure there are no leaks or issues. If any problems occur, the crucial changes are made.
